

ADULT DIVISION

The main issues addressed in the treatment:

- Depression or emotional distress (a bad mood for a long period of time, feeling depressed, sad, helpless, hopeless, not motivated, anxious, irritable, having trouble concentrating and organizing your work, sleeping, eating)
- Mood swings. Manic depression (sudden changes in your mood from hyperactivity and irritability with inappropriate behavior such as impulsive spending or gambling to being depressed and apathetic)
- Anxiety (excessive nervousness and worry, difficult to control)
- Social Phobia (persistent fear in being exposed to unfamiliar people and situations)
- Panic Attacks (intense fear or discomfort accompanied by several symptoms: difficulty to breath, heart palpitation, sweating, chest pain, nausea, etc)
- Post-traumatic stress disorder (emotional distress after accident, sexual /physical abuse or other traumatic event)
- Obsessive-compulsive disorder (emotional distress due to recurrent thoughts or repetitive behavior)
- Adjustment to major life-changes: such as immigration, loss of loved ones, divorce, grief and loss or dealing with a medical problem, marital problems, divorce or separation, work-family issues or teen relationships
- Relationship issues
- Anger/stress management
- Attention deficit disorder (Adult ADD)
- Eating disorders
- Alcohol and Drug related addictions
- Sexual dysfunctions (impotence, premature/retarded ejaculation, desire problem, problem with reaching an orgasm)
- Memory loss (due to aging or due to Alzheimer's disease, Vascular Dementia)
- Being a caregiver of mentally ill person
- Schizophrenia and other psychotic conditions



CHILD AND ADOLESCENTS DIVISION

We work with children ages 2 and up presenting with:

- Attention-Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder
- Depression (feelings of sadness, loneliness, or hopelessness and these feelings do not go away)
- Lost interest in activities and hobbies
- Low self-esteem
- Experiencing changes in sleep and eating patterns
- Avoiding friends or other relationships
- Showing lack of concentration
- Crying often with no reason or shuts down without any explanations
- Anxiety (nervousness, being often worried, panic attacks)
- Posttraumatic Stress Disorder (nightmares, bed-wetting, fears due to traumatic event)
- School Phobia
- Academic problems
- Oppositional-Defiant Disorder
- Anger/ Inability to cope with stress
- Distortion of Body Image
- Drug or Alcohol Addictions
- Difficulty to adjust to life changes (parents' separation/divorce, grief and loss, dealing with medical problem)
- Bed-wetting
